

## The Woodbury Scholarship Fund

(WSF) was created in 1975 and incorporated as a non-profit organization on June 30, 1976. Among the original members are long-time Woodbury residents Midge Baldrige, Jane Cushman, George Roberts, and Neil Yarhouse. In 1992, the WSF voted to affiliate with the Citizen's Scholarship Foundation of America. While still managed entirely on the local level, membership in the national organization gives the WSF tax exempt status, access to a wide scope of information and expertise, and in some cases, the availability of matching funds.

The WSF is organized to manage endowments and present scholarships to deserving resident high school graduates. Through the generosity of many individuals, businesses, and other organizations, the WSF scholarships have provided needed financial assistance and have been a source of valuable recognition and encouragement for academic achievement and Community service. As a volunteer organization, the WSF is able to return in scholarship awards almost all raised funds.

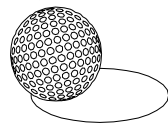

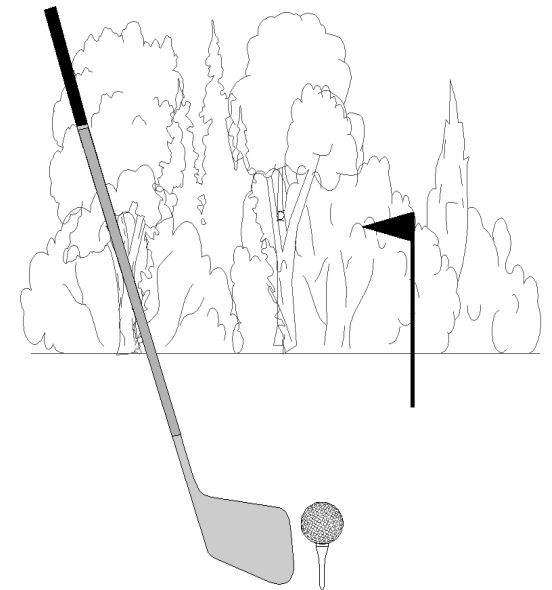
